

Adam Waldeck has worked for nearly 15 years at the intersection of politics, fundraising and advocacy, helping impact the national conversation and implement conservative policies.

Adam began his career with former Speaker of the House Newt Gingrich, directing coalitions and advocacy campaigns at American Solutions, such as the national “Drill Here, Drill Now, Pay Less” petition campaign which recruited over 1.5 million Americans in favor of expanded energy development. During Gingrich’s 2012 presidential run, he served first as National Coalitions Director, and then State Director of the successful South Carolina primary campaign.

After his time with Gingrich, Adam went on to lead American Legacy PAC where he recruited over 600,000 supporters and raised over \$6 million in support of the Dr. Ben Carson-chaired Save Our Healthcare project, focused on repealing and replacing Obamacare. When Carson joined the 2016 presidential race, Adam was tapped to help lead the national, small-dollar fundraising efforts.

Most recently, Adam has continued to develop and manage advocacy campaigns at American Legacy Center, where he continued his work with Dr. Carson as well as other national voices like former Army Ranger and Benghazi hero Kris “Tanto” Paronto.

Originally from Connecticut, Adam holds a Bachelor’s Degree in Political Science from Trinity College in Hartford.
